Goal 5: Enhance transit infrastructure, rolling stock, and facilities

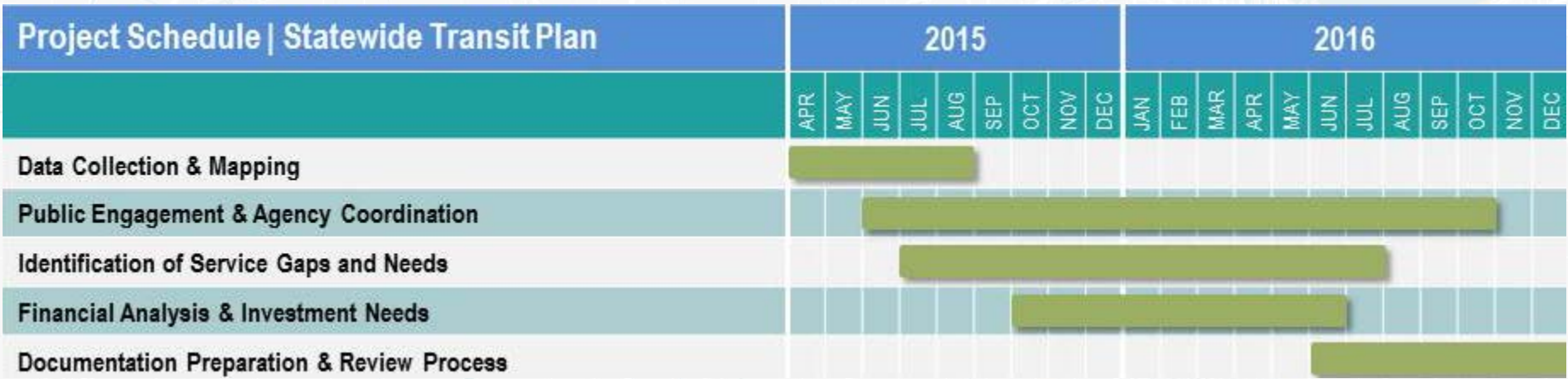

Plan Elements

- Identify future public transit services
- Determine operating and capital funding needs
- Develop meaningful performance measures

Funding Sources

Federal:

- Section 5307 (Urban Formula Program)
- Section 5311 (Rural Formula Program)
- Section 5339 (Bus and Bus Facilities Capital)
- Section 5310 (Capital Discretionary)





Funding Sources

State:

- Capital Assistance (Bond Revenue, ARRA program)
- Downstate Operating Assistance Program (DOAP)

Local:

- Contract Services
- Contributions from Municipalities/Counties/Townships
- Fares
- Advertising Revenues
